TOWERS, ALABASTER AND VESTIGES OF THE GOLDEN AGE

A DAY IN VOLTERRA & SAN GIMIGNANO

Meet your English-speaking driver at your Florence hotel and depart for a memorable day spent discovering two of Tuscany's most fascinating historical towns: mysterious Volterra and tower-crowned San Gimignano. Travel through the countryside and reach Volterra, somewhat off-the-beaten-track this is no doubt Tuscany's most bewitching town. Inhabited since the Iron Age, the town dates back over 3000 years and offers visitors an authentic journey into its rich, eventful history thanks to the exceptionally well-preserved remnants of each historic/artistic period. Meet your dedicated English-speaking guide and set off to explore, learning all about the ancient "Velathri" (later transformed into Volterrae by the Romans), and how it became one of the most powerful and important towns of the Etruscan Confederation. It's strategic location and unique natural resource, alabaster, were its assets. Ever since ancient times, in fact, Volterra's main commercial activity was the extraction of alabaster, the only translucent mineral existing in nature. This marvelous, somewhat magical stone was and is still today, used to create beautiful works of art including sculptures, jewelry, and other objects of all kinds. During the morning discover the grand Etruscan walls and imposing Porta all'Arco which embrace the town center, and stroll through the delightful main town center, tightly enveloped in a second set of walls, which boasts a perfectly maintained Medieval structure. Savor Volterra's unique ancient atmosphere in its intriguing tiny streets and alleys and visit the main landmarks and sites: Palazzo dei Priori, Vallebuona and the Etruscan Acropolis. Discover marble-paved churches, imposing palaces, Medieval tower-houses, and the Fortezza, built by the Medici family. Crown your morning with a luscious lunch accompanied by excellent wines in one of the town's trattorias, and after lunch set off once more for a scenic drive to San Gimignano. Enjoy some time at leisure in the "town of the 100 towers" roaming the pretty cobblestone-paved streets and browsing the quaint shops filled with unique local products: delicious Vernaccia white wine, Italian ceramics, and home linens.

Arrive at the launch site to be welcomed by your pilot. Our pilots are experienced professionals with Commercial Balloon Pilot Licenses and many hundreds of hours of experience, so you're in safe hands. The pilot will introduce you to hot air ballooning and give you a full safety briefing. Climb into the balloon basket for lift-off, rising smoothly towards the clouds. It's an almost motionless experience so, have your camera ready for amazing views of the patchwork landscape and possible wildlife sightings. The only thing breaking the silence will be the occasional roar of the burners. After a magical hour in the sky, the pilot will find a suitable landing spot and bring the balloon to land. Still glowing from the experience, enjoy a Tuscan breakfast with local products and a glass of wine or soft drink to accompany. The whole experience will last about 5 hours and can be added to customized itineraries. Follow to by a pleasant drive through the Chianti, after this experience, you can relax, reflect and regale while tasting some lavish Chianti wines at a nearby winery before getting back to the hotel.

PALIO DI SIENA

Held in honor of the Virgin Mary the race takes place twice a year, on July 2 and August 16. Ten of the city's seventeen contrade, districts, are represented by a horse and jockey in each race. What's so unique about this race is that it's no tourist-board invention, like some of Italy's supposedly 'Medieval' fairs, jousts and pageants and it's certainly not staged for the benefit of visitors: it has been held in Siena's Piazza del Campo ever since 1644, and the 40,000 Sieneese who crowd into the Campo on race day are largely oblivious of their Italian and international guests. Join the locals, feel the blood-rush, and experience authentic Tuscan excitement at il Palio! You're guaranteed an electric atmosphere, and you want to be comfortable to enjoy it all at best. 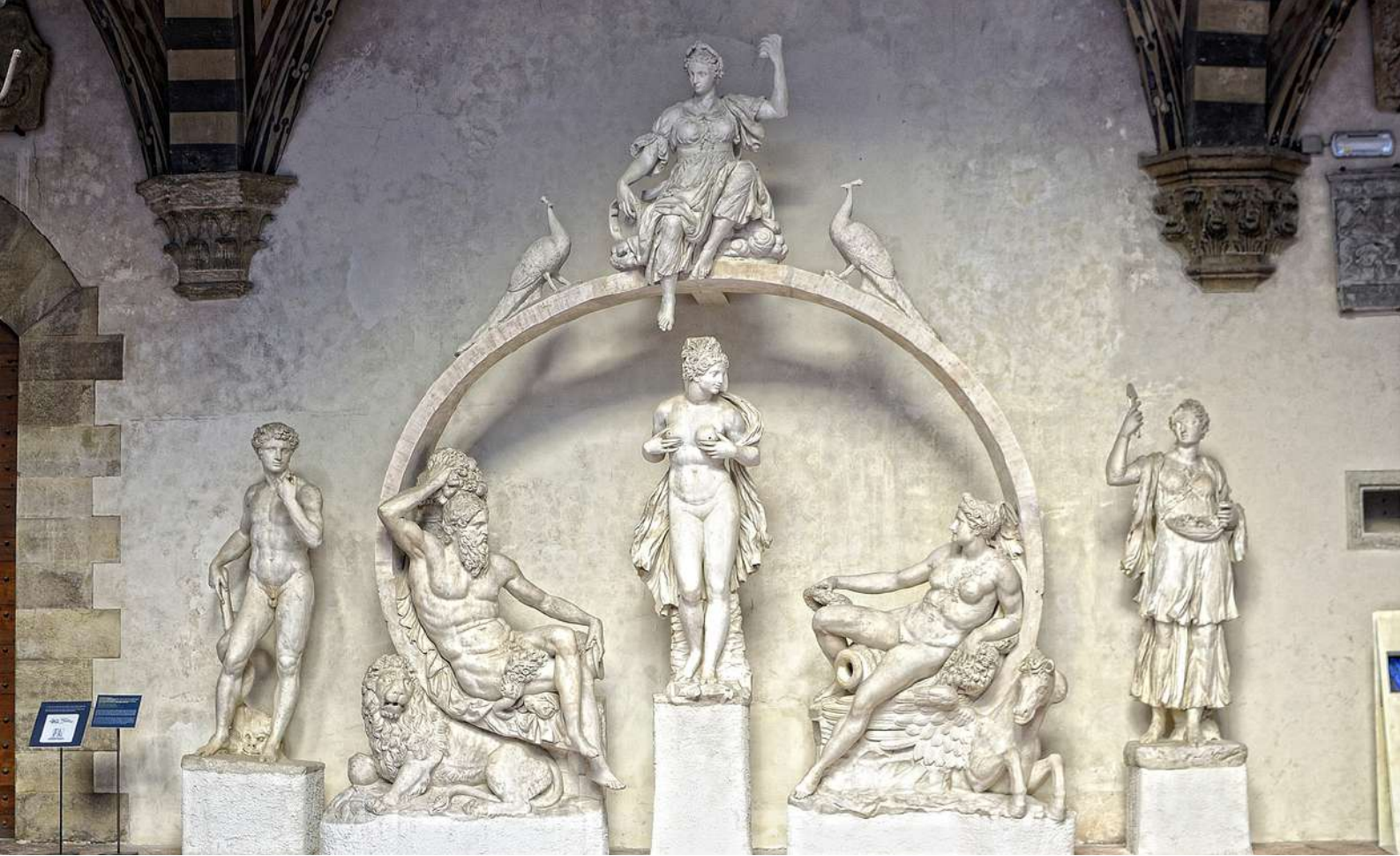

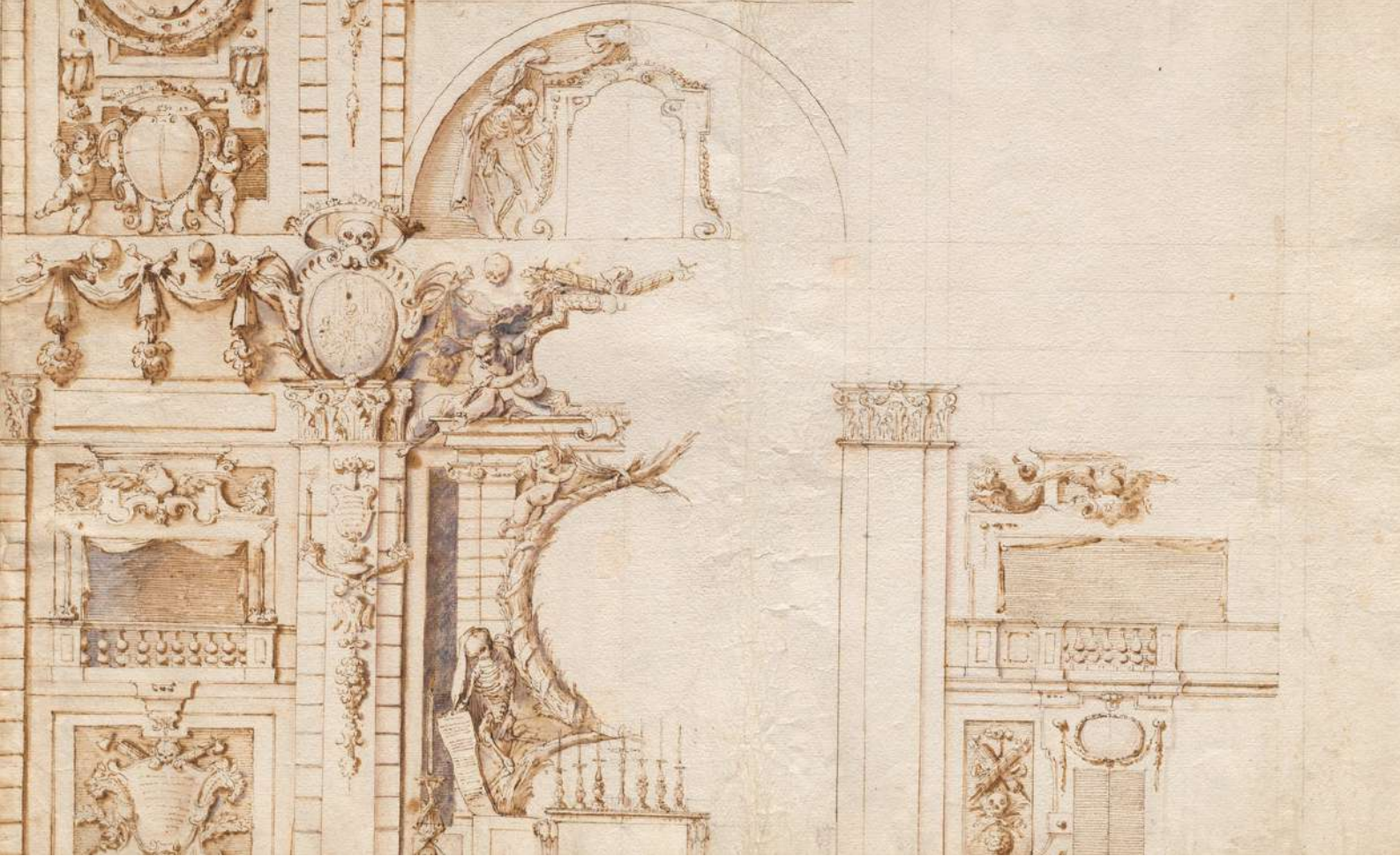

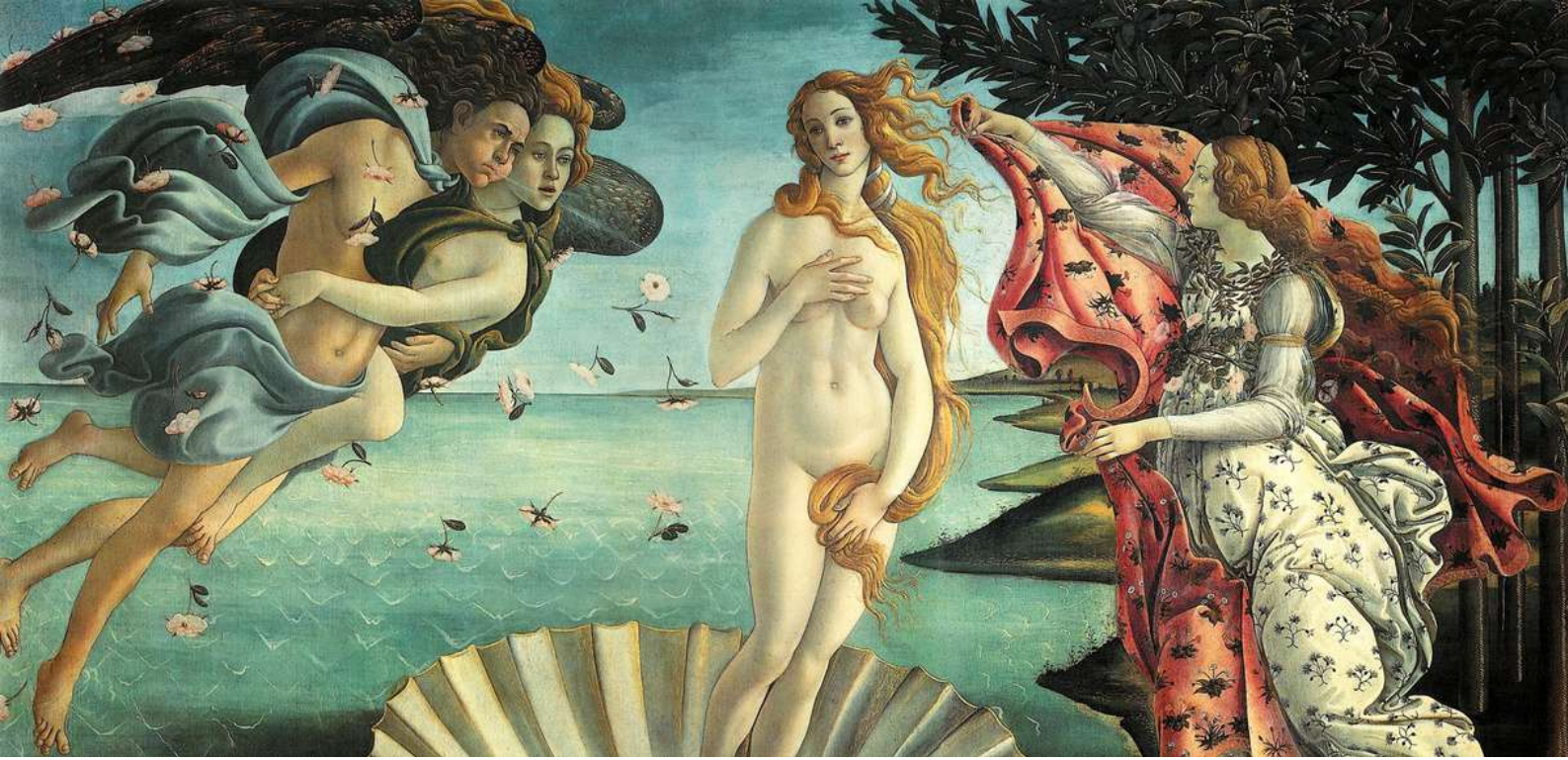
